Letters in {curly brackets} are used in discussions of Croatian phonology and poetics. Letters in [square brackets] Đ đ, Dž dž, Ǽ ǽ, Ǻ ǻ, Ć ć, and K̇ k̇ are often used to transliterate the Serbian and Macedonian letters S s, Ы ы, Ь ь, Њ њ, Ћ ћ, and К к. (Dz does not have its own place in the alphabetical order and so does not appear in the repertoire above.)
